

Terms and Conditions for Study at NIT London (2026/27)

1. Introduction

1.1

This document governs the relationship between you, as a student enrolled on a programme of study at **Northernhamshire Hexford Tessor (NIT) College of Technology London** (“NIT London”, “we”, “us”, “our”), and outlines the contractual terms under which educational services are provided to you, as well as your obligations as an applicant and student (the “Terms and Conditions”).

1.2

These Terms and Conditions apply once you accept an offer of admission to any undergraduate, postgraduate, diploma, or professional programme (each referred to as a “Programme”) at NIT London.

1.3

A legally binding contract is formed between you and NIT London upon your acceptance of the offer. You are strongly advised to read these Terms and Conditions carefully before accepting your offer.

2. The Legal Contract Between You and NIT London

2.1

In addition to these Terms and Conditions, the following documents form part of your legal agreement with NIT London:

- Your official Offer Letter
- NIT London Student Charter
- All institutional policies, procedures, and regulations (as updated from time to time)
- Programme specifications and information provided at the time of admission

2.2

These policies and procedures include (but are not limited to):

- Admissions, registration, and attendance requirements
- Tuition fees, deposits, and payment policies
- Academic conduct, progression, and assessment
- Student behaviour, discipline, and fitness to study
- Equality, diversity, and inclusion policies
- Use of campus facilities, IT systems, and learning resources

2.3

By accepting your offer, you agree to comply with all applicable policies and regulations issued by NIT London.

2.4

In the event of any conflict between these Terms and Conditions and other institutional documents, these Terms and Conditions shall take precedence.

2.5

NIT London reserves the right to update or amend its policies, procedures, and student charter. Any significant changes will be communicated via official student communication channels.

3. Offer and Registration

3.1

Your admission to NIT London is subject to meeting the conditions stated in your Offer Letter.

3.2

Offers may be **conditional or unconditional**. Conditional offers require you to meet specified academic or administrative requirements before enrolment.

3.3

Failure to meet the stated conditions within the given timeframe may result in withdrawal of the offer.

3.4

You may be required to provide supporting documentation, including:

- Academic certificates and transcripts
- Proof of English language proficiency
- Identification documents (passport or national ID)
- Health or background checks (where applicable)

3.5

NIT London reserves the right to withdraw an offer or terminate registration if:

- Required documentation is not provided
- False or misleading information is submitted
- Eligibility criteria are not met

3.6

Students must complete registration within the specified enrolment period. Failure to do so may result in loss of place.

3.7

Unregistered students are not permitted to attend classes, access learning resources, or participate in assessments.

4. Immigration and Visa Requirements

4.1

Students are responsible for ensuring they hold valid immigration permission to study in the UK (if applicable).

4.2

NIT London may request proof of visa status during admission and throughout the duration of study.

4.3

Failure to comply with visa requirements may result in withdrawal from the programme.

4.4

Students must comply with all visa conditions and inform NIT London of any changes to their immigration status.

5. Student Responsibilities

5.1

As a student of NIT London, you are expected to act as a responsible representative of the institution.

5.2

You agree to:

- Comply with all academic and institutional policies
- Maintain satisfactory attendance and engagement
- Complete all academic requirements and assessments
- Demonstrate appropriate conduct at all times

5.3

Failure to meet these responsibilities may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of enrolment.

6. NIT London Obligations

6.1

NIT London will:

- Deliver programmes with reasonable care and academic quality
- Provide appropriate teaching, learning resources, and academic support
- Offer feedback on assessments in a timely manner

6.2

We are committed to equality, diversity, and inclusion, ensuring fair treatment for all students.

6.3

Support services will be available to assist students with academic, personal, or accessibility needs.

7. Fees, Deposits, and Payments

7.1

Students are responsible for paying all tuition fees and associated costs as outlined in their Offer Letter.

7.2

Fees may vary depending on programme and student status.

7.3

Deposits (if applicable):

- Are required to secure your place
- Are typically non-refundable except under specific conditions

7.4

Failure to pay fees may result in:

- Suspension of access to classes and services
 - Withholding of results or certificates
 - Termination of enrolment
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8. Cancellation Rights

8.1

You have the right to cancel your acceptance within **14 days** of accepting your offer.

8.2

If you cancel within this period, you may be eligible for a full refund of payments made.

8.3

Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing.

9. Termination by NIT London

9.1

NIT London may terminate your enrolment if:

- Admission conditions are not met
- Fraudulent information is provided
- Fees remain unpaid
- Academic progress is unsatisfactory
- Student conduct breaches institutional policies

9.2

Termination may result in loss of access to all academic services and facilities.

10. Programme Changes

10.1

NIT London reserves the right to make reasonable changes to programmes where necessary.

10.2

In cases of significant changes:

- Students will be informed in advance
 - Alternative options may be offered
 - Students may withdraw without penalty if adversely affected
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11. Liability

11.1

NIT London will take reasonable care in delivering its services but is not liable for losses beyond its control.

11.2

We are not responsible for loss of personal belongings unless caused by negligence.

12. Data Protection

12.1

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

12.2

Information may be shared with relevant authorities, partners, or service providers where necessary.

13. Complaints Procedure

13.1

Students may raise concerns through the official complaints procedure.

13.2

NIT London is committed to resolving issues fairly and efficiently.

14. General Terms

14.1

These Terms and Conditions constitute the full agreement between you and NIT London.

14.2

They are governed by **English Law**, and disputes fall under the jurisdiction of UK courts.
